- **Paper deadline: 15 March 2010**
 - *Length: ~15-30 pp. double spaced*
 - *Primary author & presenter is a junior researcher (graduate student, research assistant, post-doc)*
 - *Submit as pdf to bhobbs@jhu.edu*
 - *All reasonable papers accepted*
 - *All authors also to be discussant for another's paper*
- **Format of meeting:**
 - *Presentation of paper (20')*
 - *2 discussants (1 student & 1 post-doc) will make a report on each paper (15' each)*
 - *General discussion (10')*
- Registrations for the seminar are accepted until 25 March, no registration fee (meals provided at cost)
- Cross-border exchanges between economics & engineering encouraged!

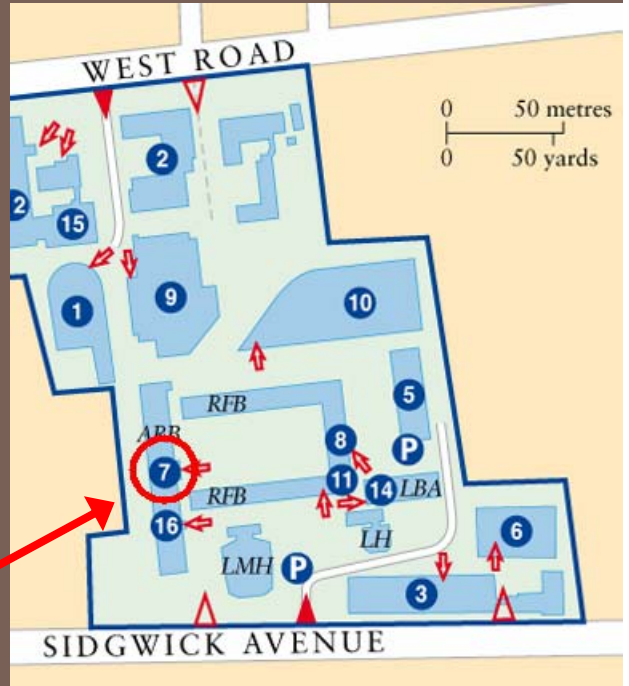

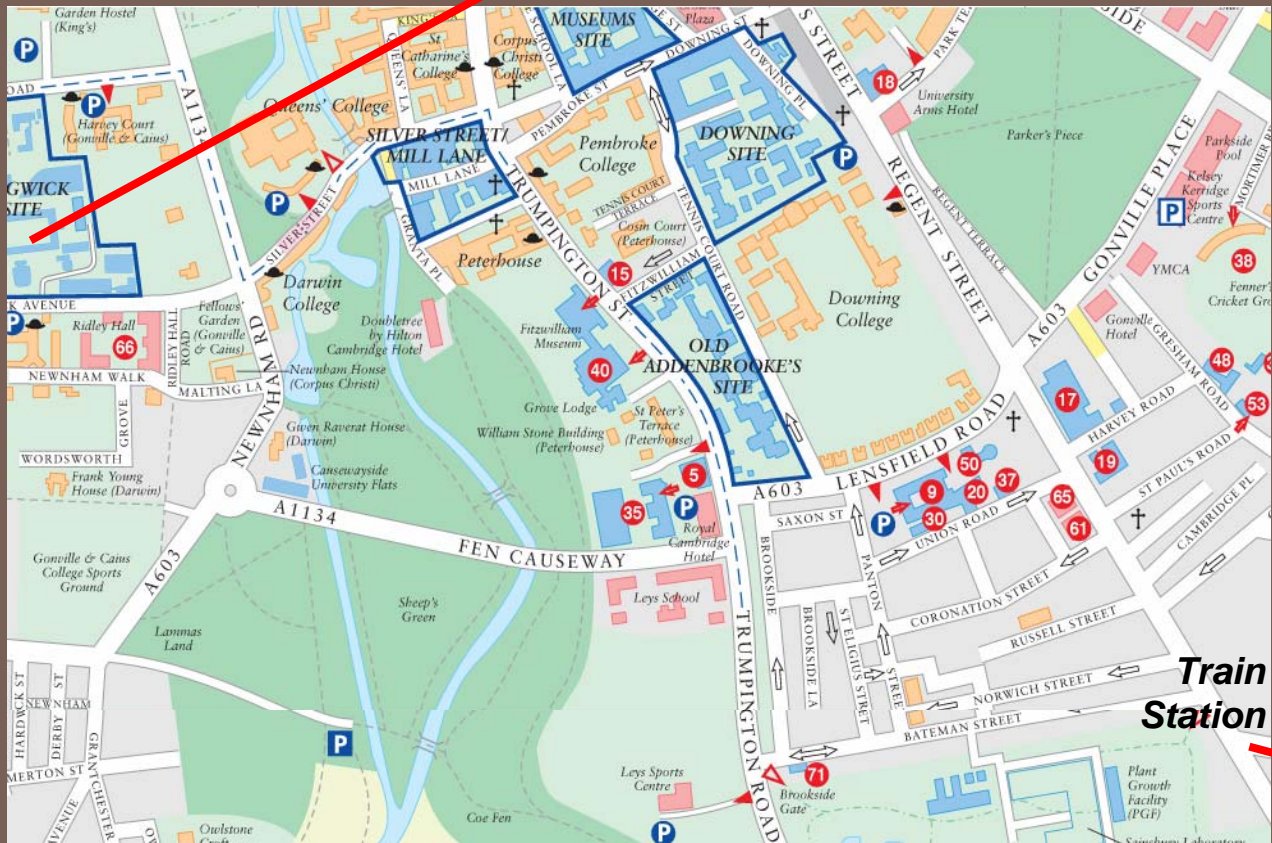
Cambridge is easily reached by:
